Conductor will:

Plan and conduct weekly rehearsals, Mondays and Wednesday, 3:30-6:15pm, at 2 Marin County locations

Coordinate programming and work collaboratively with current Lower Division instructor who teaches Tuesday and Thursday classes

Incorporate music theory curriculum into weekly rehearsals

Select appropriate repertoire, as approved by the Artistic Director

Work with the Artistic Director to build and grow the current scope of the Lower Division

Conduct All Lower Division performances and outreach performances

Fully prepare for rehearsals and performances in advance

Provide timely student evaluations, once per semester

Attend monthly faculty meetings

Attend and assist with vocal placement hearings

Qualifications:

Minimum of Bachelor's degree in Music Performance or Music Education

Significant teaching experience at the lower elementary level

Collaborative spirit and positive attitude

A love for teaching young children the importance of musical literacy and vocal technique

Required to work occasional weekends/evenings during concert season and attend Chorus events
